REPORT OF CONSERVATOR OF THE PERSON RE: STATUS OF CONSERVATEE'S CONDITION

21 Francine Teitelbaum ("Conservator"), as Conservator of the Person of Eunice D Bellah,
22 Conservatee ("Conservatee"), hereby present her *Report of Conservator of the Person Re Status*
23 *of Conservatee's Condition*, and states as follows

24 **I. BACKGROUND.**

25 1 Conservator's last report regarding the status of Conservatee's condition was filed
26 in this matter on February 14, 2011

27 2. On March 17, 2011, Conservatee was placed in Shalev Senior Living ("Shalev"),
28 located at 5805 Hillview Park Avenue, Valley Glen, CA 91401 Prior to her transfer to Shalev.

2102 2012

1 Conservatee was residing at Sunrise Studio City ("Sunrise") located at 4610 Coldwater Canyon
2 Boulevard, Studio City, CA 91604

3 3 Conservator felt that it was in the best interest of Conservatee to move from
4 Sunrise to Shalev Sunrise had demonstrated difficulties with implementing Conservatee's
5 physician's orders, following Conservator's instructions, and communicating Conservatee's
6 needs to other staff members

7 4 On August 29, 2011 Conservatee was moved to Canyon Oaks Nursing and Rehab
8 Center ("Canyon Oaks") for skilled nursing and physical therapy where she currently resides

9 **II. MEDICAL CONDITION.**

10 5 Conservatee was hospitalized at Tarzana Hospital on August 18, 2011 due to
11 respiratory distress A medical procedure was performed on August 21, 2011, and changes made
12 to Conservatee's medications

13 6 A visit with Conservatee on August 24, 2011 found her to be in good spirits and
14 feeling better

15 7 Conservatee was discharged on August 29, 2011 to Canyon Oaks from Tarzana
16 Hospital for skilled nursing and physical therapy

17 8 On September 7, 2011, Conservatee was transported to West Hills Hospital with
18 dehydration

19 9 Conservatee was not tolerating feedings, in medical distress and was placed in
20 intensive care

21 10 There were concerns for Conservatee aspirating, and between September 19, 2011
22 and September 22, 2011, Conservatee was supplemented with a G-Tube for feeding

23 11 Conservatee continued to improve and was discharged back to Canyon Oaks on
24 September 22, 2011

25 12 Conservatee was admitted to Tarzana Hospital for vascular problems of the leg
26 Medical procedure performed on December 2, 2011 and discharged back to Canyon Oaks on
27 December 5, 2011

28 13 On January 2, 2012 Conservatee was admitted to Tarzana Hospital due to vitals

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1 being out of range Conservatee was treated and discharged back to Canyon Oaks on January 5,
2 2012

3 **III. CURRENT STATUS OF CONSERVATEE.**


4 14 Conservatee is doing well at Canyon Oaks She receives 4 hours of caregivers
5 services two times a week to ensure that she is eating properly

6 15 Although Conservatee is wheelchair bound, she does have activities at Canyon
7 Oaks, and Conservator and/or her staff visit at least once a week


8 16 Conservator continues to consult with dieticians regarding an adequate diet for
9 Conservatee In addition, Conservatee undergoes swallow studies and therapy to help aid her in
10 eating/swallowing techniques The long term care goal is for the removal of the G-Tube
11 supplement so Conservatee may return to Shalev

12 I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of California that the


